My name is Ron Kerber and I am a graduate of the (b)(6) Associate Degree program and a graduate of the (b)(6) Bachelor degree program. I am also currently enrolled the (b)(6) Associate degree program planning to graduate in June (b)(6) Following graduation, I plan to enroll in the (b)(6) Bachelor Degree program.

The practical hands on experience we receive at ITT Tech is hard to come by. Our capstone classes really drive us to show how much we have learned throughout our degree. For my (b)(6) Capstone Project in 2012, I demonstrated voice automated residential home by using a microcontroller. I demonstrated how to control lighting, not only on and off but different intensities. I also had demonstrated temperature control. I designed a customer circuit in order to power everything.

For my current capstone project in (b)(6) I met with the (b)(6) classes in hopes to create a larger scale Capstone project that would include all three programs here at ITT Tech. The capstone project is based on the national electrical grid. The project will demonstrate how the utilities generate power by using fossil fuels, hydroelectric, nuclear power, and renewable energy such as wind generation and solar generation. This will also break down how each facility operates. The Drafting and Design students created 3D models of a solar equipped house, fossil fuel facility, hydroelectric facility, nuclear facility, wind turbine, substation, and solar generating facility. Along with the 3D models and elevation and section cuts are created labeling each part. All the models are to be placed on a display with an underlay of google earth showing location and proximity of facilities. Each facility was chosen by location. They are all on the same river. Each facility is broken down to location, operation and construction. The Electronics Engineering students created an interactive display by using a microcontroller and custom design lighting boards as each topic is covered the corresponding model will light up to show location on the map. The lighting is controlled by a remote. There is also an AC/DC generator, and a solar panel that explains how electricity is created. The AC/DC generator and the solar panel is setup in a way that they will generate electricity and go through boosters that increase the voltage and route it to different parts of the grid. This is how the electrical substation is demonstrated. The solar house was designed to be connected to the electrical grid and run off solar during the day and the utilities at night. The Networking students broke down the supervisory control and data acquisition system (SACDA). This is the way the utilities can communicate with the different facilities on the grid. SACDA is comprised of human interface units (HMI), supervisory (computer) systems, remote terminal units, programmable logic controllers and communication infrastructure.

With the time I have spent at ITT Tech - Charlotte South I was able to obtain the valuable tools needed to work and understand the engineering field whether it is electrical or design implementing the different techniques and different software platforms.

Today, I am employed at (b)(6) assisting in the design of electrical substation across the country. The quality of the education I received at ITT Tech has provided me with everything I need to be successful in my career field for years to come.
